1.	<b>Law 107/2016 on electricity</b>	Amendment of Law 107/2016 on electricity arising from the need to guarantee energy security, ensure the efficient operation and monitoring of the power sector; ensuring free access to the electricity market; promotion of electricity production; ensuring the appropriate balance between supply and demand, the appropriate level of interconnection capacity to facilitate cross-border exchanges of electricity; development of the electricity market and integration into a competitive electricity market	<b>Accomplished:</b> Following several meetings and EBA paper positions the Parliament adopted the amendments to the Law. Entered into force as of 28 <sup>th</sup> of December.
2.	<b>Law 10/2016 on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources</b>	Amendment of Law 10/2016 on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources by sustainable energy development through energy efficiency measures and the promotion of electricity production from renewable sources	<b>Accomplished:</b> After 8 meetings at different levels and following several EBA Position Papers, inclusively approaching the issue through public events organized by EBA, the law was adopted in November by the Parliament. In force from December 23 <sup>rd</sup> .
3.	<b>Government Decision no. 401/2021 regarding the approval of capacity limits, maximum quotas and capacity categories in the field of electricity from renewable sources valid until December 31, 2025</b>	Amendment of Government Decision no. 401/2021 following the approval of Law no. 10/2016 regarding the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources the Government shall establish the quotas of capacity, by categories of final beneficiaries, for which capacity ceilings can also be established individual per power plant, to be offered for the implementation of the net billing mechanism.	<b>Accomplished:</b> Following several meetings and EBA paper positions the draft GD was approved by the Government and entered into force starting with 18.01.2024
4.	<b>Government Decision no. 690/2018 for the approval of the Regulation on the tenders launching for offering the eligible producer status</b>	Amendment of GD no. 690/2018 for the approval of the for the approval of the Regulation on the tenders launching for offering the eligible producer status following the adopted amendments to Law 10/2016 on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources	<b>In process</b> In December 2023 a Document Position with relevant proposals was submitted to the Ministry of Energy.
