1.	Tax policy 2025	Promoting measures to support business, priority proposals for Tax Policy 2025	Partially accomplished:  EBA proposals submitted to MF, discussed within EBA Tax Committee meetings (7 meetings) and the meeting with Minister of Finance (09.04.2024, 21.06.2024) and with Economy, Budget and Finance Parliamentary Commission (17.07.2024).  Among the 2024 Fiscal Policy priorities identified by EBA (147 proposals), the following were accepted:  1. Approval of the Stock Option (incentive) plan concept.  2. Approval of benefits for employee sports subscriptions.  3. Acceptance of the proposal to eliminate the deductibility cap of 5% from the wage fund for employer expenses related to compensating childcare services for employees' children, aiming to reduce legislative ambiguities and administrative burdens.  4. Redefinition of the term "Promotional Campaign" to include various types of incentives.  5. Acceptance of the proposal regarding equity titles and clarification of their tax regime.  6. A series of proposed and accepted changes to Chapter VII on Local Taxes in the Fiscal Code.  EBA submitted Position Paper No. 39/24-SD on March 18, 2024, to the Tax Service, Position Paper No. 85/24-SD on June 19, 2024, to the Ministry of Finance, and Position Paper No. 100/24-SD on July 15, 2024, to the Economy, Budget, and Finance Parliamentary Commission. These papers addressed the Law for the amendment of certain normative acts concerning budget-fiscal policy, which was subsequently approved through Law No. 212/2023.  The following meetings were held concerning the Fiscal Policy discussions:  1. Meeting with Mrs. Olga Golban, Director of the Tax Service, on April 9, 2024.  2. Ministry of Finance meeting on Fiscal Policy proposals for 2025, on June 21, 2024.  3. Economic Journalism Academy discussion with the Minister of Finance on Fiscal Policy for 2025, on July 10, 2024.  4. EBA Tax & Customs Meeting on April 1, 2024.  6. 			On July 31, 2025, Law No. 214 of 31.07.2024 (entering into force on 01.01.2025) amending certain normative acts related to the budgetary-fiscal and Customs Policy, as well as Law No. 311 of 26.12.2024 (also entering into force on 01.01.2025) amending certain normative acts concerning the Fiscal and Customs policy, were approved. These acts include some of the proposals submitted by EBA through its Position Papers.
2.	Extending tax neutrality	The proposal is to extend tax neutrality principle from the perspective of income tax and VAT in relation to actions taken by the local companies in regard with Ukrainian refugee's support.	In process: Position Paper submitted to the Prime-minister, Government, Ministry of Finance & Ministry of Economic Development and Digitization.
3.	Adjusting the meal voucher legislation to the current regulatory framework	Amendment of the legislation on meal vouchers to the current legislation, i.e. amendment of Law No 166/2017 and Government Decision No 227/2018	In process: Following the request of the business community, the EBA has repeatedly mentioned the need to adjust the regulatory framework for meal vouchers. Subsequently EBA presented its proposals in the following Position Papers: No. 48-23/SD of 12.06.2023, about Law No 166/2017 on meal vouchers and No. 63-23/SD of 16.08.2023, about Draft on meal vouchers granted to employers. The EBA also held meetings of the Taxation Committee on 08 June, 12 June and 05 July 2023. Partially accomplished:  EBA presented a Position Paper and participated in several meetings on the same topic with representatives of the Congress of Local Authorities of Moldova and MDED and the meetings organized by the municipality of Chişinău. Partially accomplished: EBA presented several changes to the internal concept proposed by the Ministry of Finance and presented Position Paper; Amendments to the Fiscal Code: As part of the 2025 Fiscal Policy exercise, a series of proposed amendments were presented, most of which were accepted and are reflected in the Law approving the 2025 Fiscal Policy. Amendments to Ministry of Finance Order No. 9 regarding the Transfer Pricing Regulation: Currently, the draft has been submitted by the Ministry of Finance for consultation, and EBA is in the stage of countering the provisions of the draft with the proposals it submitted in September.  - Position Paper No. 84-24/SD of 19 June 2024 - Position Paper No. 151-24/SD of 18 December 2024;  On March 11, 2025, the Order of the Ministry of Finance was approved regarding the amendment of the Minister of Finance's Order No. 9/2024 on the approval of the rules for implementing transfer pricing, Order No. 21 of March 11, 2025 (entered into force on March 14, 2025).
