1.	The new Law on electricity	The complexity of this normative act aims not only to transpose EU rules into national legislation but also to integrate the energy sector of the Republic of Moldova into the EU, regulating new market participants, new functions for TSOs, market rules and market operator's duties. It is necessary to present by the author the new concept, the changes made compared to the existing legal framework, the stages of implementation of the new law, as well as other important aspects of clarification for market participants.	Partially Accomplished: In the context of initiated public consultations on the new law on electricity, on October 2024 and 2025 EBA submitted several Position Papers to the Ministry of Energy. EBA proposals were discussed during the follow up meetings. The draft of the new Electricity Law adopted by the Parliament No 164/2025, in force since 19.08.2025
2.	Regulation on guarantees of origin	Amendment of Government Decision 376/2017 in order to establish the framework for the organization and functioning of the system of guarantees of origin for electricity produced from renewable sources with reference to the Law 10/2016 on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources by sustainable energy development	Accomplished: Government Decision 376/2017 repealed by ANRE Decision no 402 of 07/15/25, effective 07/18/25
3.	Government Decision no. 401/2021 regarding the approval of capacity limits, maximum quotas and capacity categories in the field of electricity from renewable sources valid until December 31, 2025	Amendment of Government Decision no. 401/2021 to accelerate investments in renewable energy production and the development of the balancing services market, which justifies the urgent need to increase the quotas for the ongoing auction for large eligible renewable energy producers and to launch the auction for balancing capacities.	Accomplished: Following several meetings and EBA position papers addressed to Prime-minister Mr. D. Recean, the GD was partially amended.
4.	Government Decision no. 690/2018 for the approval of the Regulation on the tenders launching for offering the eligible producer status	Amendment of GD no. 690/2018 for the approval of the Regulation on the tenders launching for offering the eligible producer status following the adopted amendments to Law 10/2016 on the promotion of the use of energy from renewable sources targeting clarifications aimed at improving the bidding process, ensuring transparency, and strengthening the attractiveness of the Republic of Moldova for investments in the field of renewable energy.	Accomplished: Two Position Papers were submitted in the context of targeting clarifications aimed at improving the bidding process, ensuring transparency, and strengthening the attractiveness of the Republic of Moldova for investments in the field of renewable energy. Most of these proposals have been taken into consideration. GD amended.
5.	Tender documentation regarding the	Procurement of balancing capacities from potential balancing service providers organized by Moldelectrica.	Accomplished:

	procurement of balancing capacities		The European Business Association (EBA Moldova) addressed the issue in the context of clarifications regarding the content of the tender documentation on the procurement of balancing capacities from potential balancing service providers. A clarification meeting was organized based on EBA request. Documentation amended accordingly.
6.	Methodology on the location, installation, and dismantling of photovoltaic power plants	Draft Methodology on the location, installation, and dismantling of photovoltaic power plants submitted to public consultation.	Accomplished: Position Paper submitted aimed at improving the process of locating, installing, and dismantling photovoltaic power plants in light of investments in renewable energy. Proposals taken into account.
7.	The new Regulation on connection to electricity networks and the provision of electricity transmission and distribution services submitted to public consultation	Draft of the new Regulation on connection to electricity networks and the provision of electricity transmission and distribution services submitted to public consultation by ANRE	In process. EBA requested a technical meeting to clarify and propose conceptual provisions. The meeting held with all involved stakeholders in December. A Position Paper submitted. ANRE committed to revise the draft regulation and to expose for repeated public consultations.
8.	Land Code No. 22/2024	Amendment to Land Code No. 22/2024 (legislative initiative No. 18 of January 27, 2025)	Partially Accomplished: EBA provided a Position Paper with disagreement to the amendment providing complementary provisions to paragraph (2) of Article 23 of the Land Code, establishing new ways of using agricultural land, with the exception of the installation of solar photovoltaic systems and the cultivation of woody energy crops. The facilities provided inequally treats the existent investors with the new one.
