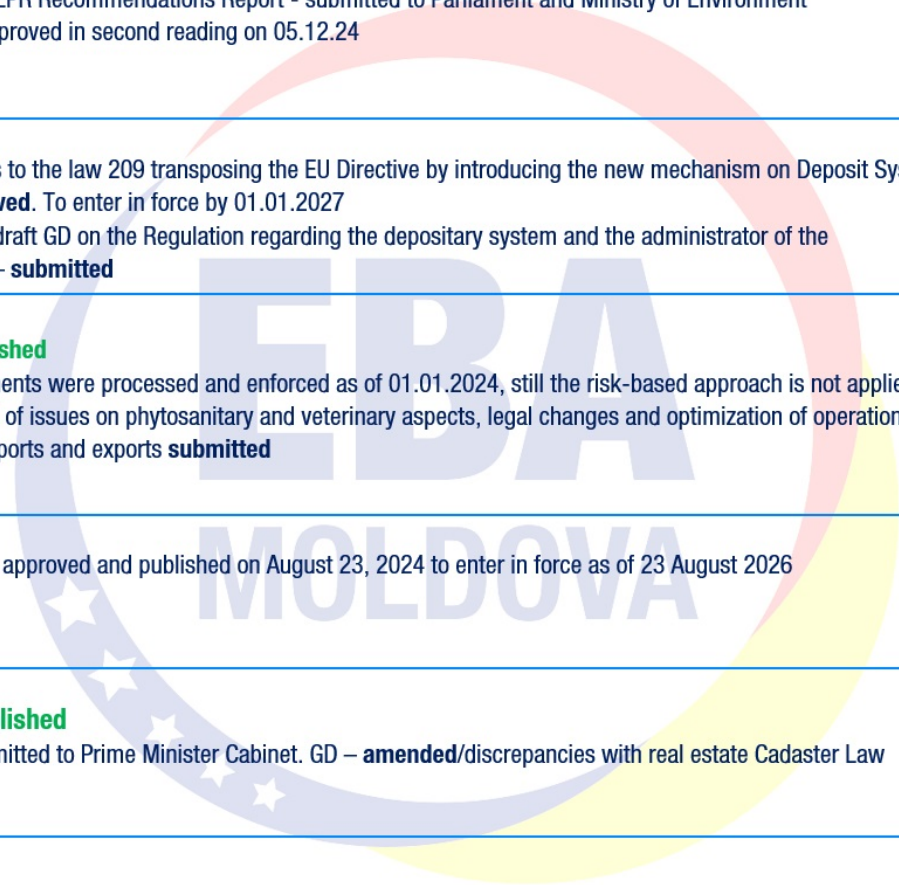

Accomplished

- Amendments to the law 209 transposing the EU Directive by introducing the new mechanism on Deposit System for packaging – **approved**. To enter in force by 01.01.2027
- EBA DPs on draft GD on the Regulation regarding the depositary system and the administrator of the depositary system – **submitted**

Partially Accomplished

- The amendments were processed and enforced as of 01.01.2024, still the risk-based approach is not applied.
- The short list of issues on phytosanitary and veterinary aspects, legal changes and optimization of operational processes in the context of imports and exports **submitted**

Accomplished

- The new law approved and published on August 23, 2024 to enter in force as of 23 August 2026

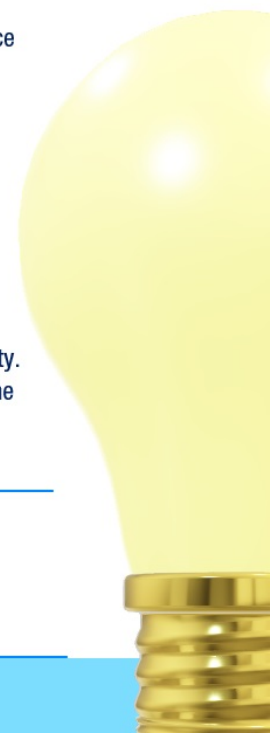

7	Electricity Law (new)	Initiated <ul style="list-style-type: none">EBA DP reflecting a list of clarifications - submitted
8	Tax policy 2025 Position Papers – 4 Meetings - 9	Partially accomplished <p>Among the 2024 fiscal policy priorities identified by EBA (147 proposals), and 24 proposal were accepted the following were accepted:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Approval of the Stock Option (incentive) plan concept.Approval of benefits for employee sports subscriptions.Acceptance of the proposal to eliminate the deductibility cap of 5% from the wage fund for employer expenses related to compensating childcare services for employees' children, aiming to reduce legislative ambiguities and administrative burdens.Redefinition of the term "Promotional Campaign" to include various types of incentives.Acceptance of the proposal regarding equity titles and clarification of their tax regime.A series of proposed and accepted changes to Chapter VII on Local Taxes in the Fiscal Code.
9	Transfer Pricing Position Papers – 3 Meetings - 5	Partially accomplished <p>Amending the Fiscal Code to exclude local transactions, revise definitions, and implement other significant changes, alongside modifying Ministry of Finance Order Nr. 9 regarding the Transfer Pricing Regulation</p> <p>Amendments to the Fiscal Code: As part of the 2025 fiscal policy exercise, a series of proposed amendments were presented, most of which were accepted and are reflected in the Law approving the 2025 Fiscal Policy.</p> <p>Amendments to Ministry of Finance Order No. 9 regarding the Transfer Pricing Regulation: Currently, the draft has been submitted by the Ministry of Finance for consultation, and EBA is in the stage of countering the provisions of the draft with the proposals it submitted in September.</p>
10	Modification of state control Position Papers – 5 Meetings – 4	In process <ul style="list-style-type: none">Amending Law Nr. 131/2012 on state control of entrepreneurial activity, as well as the secondary regulatory framework related to each control authority. EBA submitted six position papers with member proposals, some of which were partially accepted, and regularly participated in meetings organized by the Disputes Council and the State Control Council, where EBA is a member.
11	Amendment of the Law on Advertising No 62/2022 Position Papers – 3 Meetings – 3	In process <p>In 2024, EBA submitted 4 Position Papers, and participated in the meeting organized with MDED and the municipality of Chişinău</p>

13	Amendment of legislation related to labor shortages and the attraction of foreign labor Position Papers – 3 Meetings - 5	In process EBA submitted two position papers and participated in meetings organized on the platforms of the commission for Social Protection, Health and Family, Ministry of Internal Affairs (MAI), and the Ministry of Economic Development and Digitalization (MDED).
14	Amendment of the regulatory framework for cash settlements Position Papers – 2 Meetings - 1	In process EBA submitted 2 Position Paper and participated at the meetings which was held by BNM.

17	Track and Trace system (tobacco) Position Papers – 1 Meetings – 2 Interview - 1 Only EBA submitted the Position Paper and participated in public consultations	In process EBA DP debated on the Parliamentary Committee "Social Protection, Health and Family Committee", underlying that proposed draft law provisions are not in line with the EU Directive 2014/40. In July, a meeting was held with the State Secretary Mrs. Cristina Ixari and the Tobacco sector regarding the importance of swiftly developing the Track and Trace Concept and its phased implementation, allowing the sector to adjust its internal systems. Relevant position papers were previously submitted. Currently, the concept is at the consultation stage.
